Princess Hope's Cotton Candy Fizz



Hope means "happy anticipation of something good". Hope's bright pink punch is an exciting introduction to the festivities that will delight each princess attending your regal party.

NECESSITIES

- Vanilla Ice Cream
- Strawberry Soda

STEP BY STEP

Place one scoop of vanilla ice cream in each goblet and pour strawberry soda over the top. The bubbly punch will create a cotton candy-like fizz that may stream over the top of the glass and surprise your astonished princesses!





Princess Faith's Dazzling Rainbow Cookies


These colorful gumdrop bites will delight your little princesses as they join you in decorating these dainty treats.

NECESSITIES

- 1 (17.5 ounce) bag of Sugar Cookie Mix
- ½ cup softened butter
- 1 large egg
- 1 tsp. peppermint extract
- 1 cup small assorted gumdrops, chopped
- Confectioners Sugar

STEP BY STEP

Preheat oven to 375. Spray mini muffin pans. Combine cookie mix, butter, egg, peppermint extract and gumdrops. Roll dougl into 1-inch balls and place in each muffin cup. Bake 8-10 minutes. Cool completely and remove from pans. Frost with Princess Joy's Jazzy Frosting and top with rainbow colored gumdrops.



Princess Joy's Jazzy Cookie Frosting

NECESSITIES

- ½ cup of softened butter
- 7 ounce jar of Marshmallow Crème
 3/4 cups of Confectioners Sugar or
 1 (8 ounce) frozen whipping crème
- tsp. of Vanilla
- Drops of milk until spreadable consistency

STEP BY STEP

In a medium bowl, combine ½ cup of butter and 1 (7-ounce) jar of Marshmallow Crème. Beat at medium speed with electric mixer until smooth. Gradually add 2 ¾ cups of confectioners' sugar or 1 (8 0z.) frozen whipping topping. Add 1 t. of vanilla and milk until spreadable consistency. Coat each cookie and top with rainbow colored gumdrops.



Princess Grace's Petite Treatwiches



Parties are always distinctive with a delectable selection of tempting nibbles. The princesses use soft, crust-less bread cut in cookie cutter shapes (hearts, rounds, fingers) in these small bites. They make a Royal Party very elegant when served on a crystal platter and garnished with fresh mint and edible flowers (pansy, nasturtium, calendula, violets and rose petals).

Delicate Nasturtium Hearts

Spread heart-shaped crust-less white bread with strawberry whipped cream cheese. Add fresh colorful Nasturtiums. So lummy!!

Posh Peanut Butter and Banana Fingers (or Hearts)

Mix extra crunch peanut butter, butter and honey together. Spread on one side of bread. Top with lots of thinly sliced bananas and sprinkle lightly with cinnamon and sugar. Best made with soft white bread on top and Honey Wheat on the bottom or use Smuckers Peanut

Butter and Jelly sandwiches and cut with

a heart cookie cutter!

Extravagant Tiny Reuben Rolls


Delicious Hawaiian Dinner Rolls cut open in half and the bottom spread lightly with Thousand Island dressing and topped with salty pastrami and melted Swiss cheese. Broil and top with dinner roll top.

Incredibly Excellent Egg Salad Morsel

Finger-shaped shepherds bread, spread with whipped cream cheese. Mix chopped egg, mayonnaise, mustard, sweet pickle relish, and salt and pepper. Cover and chill.

Lavish Chicken Salad

Finely chop chicken, celery, and walnuts. Mix in mayonnaise and a pinch of curry. Spread on soft round-shaped bread or mini croissants.



Princess Charity's Chewy Chicken Nibblets



NECESSITIES

3/4 cup flour

- 1 large egg
- 1 cup panko Japanese crumbs
- 2 Tbs. Dry Ranch Dressing Mix
- 1 pound boneless, skinless Chicken Breasts, cut in 1" cubes Vegetable Oil Barbecue Dipping Sauce Homemade Ranch Dressing

STEP BY STEP

In a small bowl, add flour.
In another small bowl, add egg.
In yet another small bowl, combine panko crumbs, dry ranch dressing mix and salt.
Dredge chicken in flour, then egg and coat with panko crumbs. Fry chicken for 5-6 minutes until golden brown and cooked through. Use a decorative pick in each piece and serve with Barbecue

Dipping Sauce and homemade Ranch Dressing.








NECESSITIES

- 8 Bananas, peeled
- 8 Wooden Popsicle sticks
- 1 6-ounce package (1 cup) Semi-Sweet Chocolate Morsels or Milk Chocolate Morsels
- 1 Tablespoon Vegetable Shortening Chopped Nuts

STEP BY STEP

Insert wooden stick in end of each banana and freeze. Melt chocolate pieces over hot, not boiling water and stir in shortening. Coat each banana with chocolate mixture and roll immediately in nuts.

Wrap each banana pop in cellophane and freeze until ready to serve. Makes 8 pops.





The Princesses Thirst-Quenching Luscious Lemonade

NECESSITIES AND STEP BY STEP

- 1 Large Can of Frozen Lemonade concentrate, thawed or 1 cup fresh lemon juice and add 1 cup of granulated sugar
- 1 Liter of lemon-lime soda or ginger ale Lots of crushed ice in each glass Drop lemon and lime slices on ice and garnish with fresh mint sprigs.

A Regal Entry

"Enthusiasm is expressing with our spirit the joy we sense in our soul". Greeting each of your guests as they make their appearance is your first opportunity to say thank you for their special friendship. Create a memory by snapping a picture of their first regal moment...



From the balloons on the stake in your lawn announcing, "The Party's Here" to your front door that is magnificent in its regal representation, the party will begin before they step through the threshold.

NECESSITIES

- A few yards of colored Tule
- Multi-colored ribbons or strung beads
- Tiaras, necklaces, bracelets, earrings, sparkly rings, glittering plastic slippers, multi-colored balloons and a stake for front lawn or planter (from 99Cent or Dollar Store)
- Markers, Glitter Pens and Poster Board for "The Party's Here"
- A curtain rod with a spring for top of the door or
- Two large nails (for top corner of door frame to drape fabric



STEP BY STEP POSSIBILITIES for communicating how extraordinary your guest is:

A few yards of colored Tule from a fabric shop could be draped around the front door entry with tiaras, pearls and jewels intertwined in the ribbon that fastens the fabric to the door frame or streamers of ribbon or beads could cascade from the top of the door frame where the girls walk through to make a dramatic entryway. A spring curtain rod could drape fabric, table clothes (even sheets or light bedspreads), to fashion an enchanting entry fit for a princess.

Pedestaled green plants could be used on each side of the entry door or porch decorated with tiaras, fancy plastic slippers, glittery wands, jewelry and even, fluffy princess dresses, if you happen to have more than one, to enhance the salutation that "your guests are genuinely being loved by thoughtfulness".

Inside the entry a "treasure" chest filled with tiaras, wands, necklaces and earrings fit for a little princess could welcome little princesses as your hostess invites them to pick one and helps them place a crown on each royal head.



Royal Reminiscence Puzzle

Being alert is part of being a true princess. Alertness is "being aware of that which is taking place around me so I can have the right response". The girls will have fun testing their alertness as they apply all their senses to remembering what they saw on the crystal platter and what is missing!

NECESSITIES

- Jeweled Tiara
- Small Glass slipper
- Sequined Wand
- String of pearls or any shiny necklace
- Pair of sparkly earrings
- Fancy glove
- Dangly Bracelet
- Dazzling Ring
- Glittery Lip Gloss
- Facial Glitter
- Whatever you may have available that is small and Princess-perfect...



STEP BY STEP

Place your chosen objects on a decorative large tray.

Gather the girls together and introduce the items one by one.

Ask for a volunteer (or your princess) to leave the room.

Remove two or three items (depending on age of group) from the tray.

Invite her back into the room to guess which items are missing.


Allow each guest an opportunity to have a turn.



The Royal Scavenger Hunt

In the book "Princess Hope and the Hidden Treasure", the princesses led us on a "hunt to find the greatest treasure ever found". Our five princesses invite you to join them on another treasure hunt. Hide the items used in the Royal Reminiscence Puzzle and explain that someone has taken all the treasures that were on the crystal platter and hidden them. Hand them a list of what has been hidden and send them seeking as many as they can find. They have a limited amount of time and may want to team up to work faster!

When the time is up call them together and see how many of the items have been found. If there is one guest that has hunted but found nothing, ask if someone with more than one item would be willing to share. If no one offers, allow the guest to choose something else from the entry gifts.






The Game of Musical Thrones

The place of honor in the castle is the King's throne. Have each girl bring her chair and form a circle in the center of the room. Ask the girls if they had ever thought about God having a throne and one day we will see Him sitting on it. He is our sovereign King of Kings! This activity gives each princess an opportunity to demonstrate kindness and making others successful first, which is the attitude of our loving heavenly King toward us.

Announce that when the music plays the girls will walk around the circle of chairs. When the music stops everyone must sit down on the chair nearest her. One chair will be removed leaving one girl without a chair each round. The girls that are watching could clap and cheer on the ones still playing. Keep removing the chairs each round and the girl left standing gets the most robust cheer! There will be lots of giggles and rushing to be first for a seat!



The Princesses Proof of Contentment Game



Are your princesses self-sensitive or sensitive toward others? In "Princess Charity's Courageous Heart" we find a determined adventurous! A bit of a "tomboy", her heart is challenged to make a decision that could impact an entire kingdom! She placed herself in danger to rescue the injured boy. Her brotherly love focused on the need of the hurting child instead of her personal safety and the danger that could come from helping him!

Let's check our level of contentment, shall we? Place one pillow for each guest on the floor. Have each girl take a turn and try to feel the ping pong/tennis ball underneath one of the fluffy pillows. Do not tell the girls what is under the pillow. Allow them to respond spontaneously, guessing what could possibly be under the one pillow. Laughter will ensue as the one with the foreign ball will most certainly react with a resounding, "what is this??"
